River, Ocean, and Mountain School (ROAMS) is an outdoor leadership program which focuses on career preparation, work experience, adventure education and community leadership in School District 69. The program introduces students to a multitude of outdoor experiences (rafting, surfing, climbing, fishing, kayaking, and ski/snowboarding) combined with industry recognized certifications:

OFA 3, Radio Operator, Bronze Cross, Food Safe, World Host, and more.

The end result, through mentorship and work experience with certified guides, develops students that have an appreciation for guide operations and the safety and responsibility that must occur in the field. The program seeks to attract students with a passion for the outdoors, a strong work ethic, dedication, responsibility, and a desire to gain work experience and eventual employment in the outdoor, adventure tourism industry.

Trips may include:

Bi-weekly river and moving water sessions.

Multi-day rafting on the Nimpkish River on Northern Vancouver Island

Surf lessons/ day trips to Tofino

Multi-day surf trip to Raft Cove

Surfing with Hooksum Outdoor

Ski trips to Mt. Washington, Whistler-Blackcomb, Revelstoke Resort, and Manning Park Resort.

Rock climbing at Romper Room in Nanaimo, Crag X in Victoria, and the Little Mountain Indoor Wall.

Work Experience at Mt. Washington, Manning Park, and Mt. Cain.
